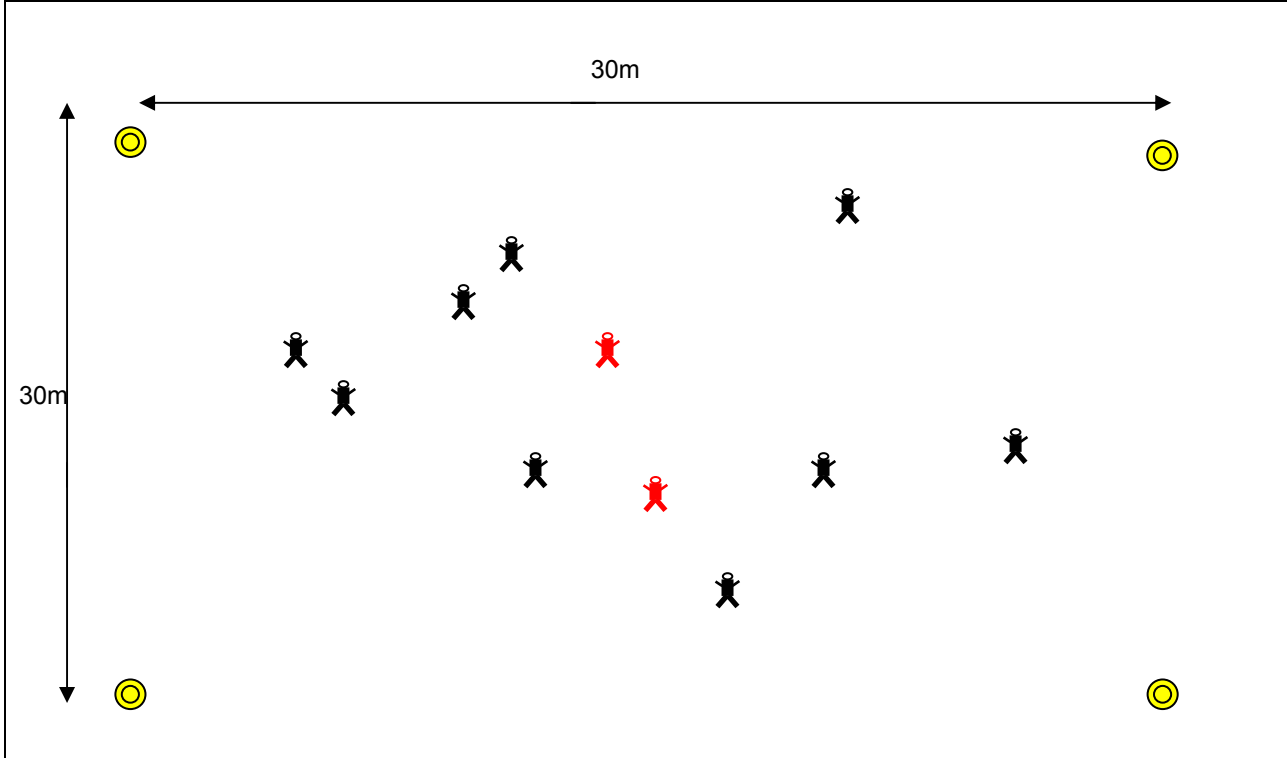
**Drill Requirements**

<b>Area</b>	30x30 grid
<b>Players</b>	All
<b>Time</b>	

**Drill Description**

- A team have to count how many passes they can make before a mistake is made.
- A mistake can be forced by one or two defenders trying to intercept the pass or touch a ball carrier.
- To increase pressure close space, add defenders or number/type of balls (tennis ball)
- Whoever makes the mistake becomes a defender

**Key Coaching Points**

- Looking for space on the pitch
- Fast flat passes are most effective
- Pass and move to space

**Relevance to the game**

Puts passing skills under pressure and highlights the need for players to pass and then become an effective support player. Also puts decision making skills under pressure.
